Dear Parents:

We are beginning the last month of school for this year. However, we still have a few activities and the final exams.

Last day for uniforms is Friday, June 13th. If students do not wear respectable clothes, they will be required to wear their uniform the rest of the year. SHORT MUST BE AT THE KNEES AND NO TANK TOPS OR FLIP FLOPS. On the day we have Mass, which is June 26th students are required to wear clothes that are appropriate for Church. That means no shorts.

The Final Exams are scheduled for students in 3rd to 5th grade beginning on Tuesday, June 17th. Check the school calendar for the test schedule.

The date for the Pre-K Graduation is on Friday, June 20th at 3:30 P.M. The Pre-K students do not have to be in school in the morning on June 20th. The Graduates are asked to be at school by 3:00 P.M. on Friday the 20th. All the Pre-K students are to be in school each day from the 23rd to 26th like the rest of the students.

The Kindergarten Graduation is on Saturday, June 21st at 2:00 pm. The graduates are to be at the school by 1:30 pm so they can get ready for their big event. They are to attend school each day from June 23rd to the 26th like the rest of the students.

Monday, June 23rd to Thursday, June 26th are half days and dismissal is at 11:30 A.M. Thursday the 26th we will have a Mass of Thanksgiving for the past year. It will be at 9:30 AM. At the Mass the 5th Graders will receive their diplomas. Mass will be followed by the awards presentation. This is the last day of school for this year.

Lewiston Porter **will not** be providing buses to take the students home the week of June 23rd to 26th because of a conflict with the High School exams. Parents of the students involved are asked to arrange to pick up their children at 11:30 am.

The sisters ask God's blessing on all who helped, in any way, to make this an enjoyable year for everyone as well as all who worked on any fundraisers to help to keep our tuition affordable.

REMINDERS:

Sr. Elena has asked the parents to kindly teach the lines your child has for Graduation. They have already been sent home.

Soon your child will be bringing home the books they have worked in and completed during the year. Please, take some time during the summer to help your child review the material so they will be ready to begin next year.

Sr. Chinedu has also asked that parents help their child with their lines that they have for the Pre- K Graduation.

As always your help is greatly appreciated.

Summer School for remedial Reading and Math as well as the Vacation Bible Camp will begin on July 14th and run to Aug. 14th. If your child will attend, please, fill out the form so we know how many students to plan for.

All tuition and fees should be paid in full by the end of May. Any outstanding tuition bills will be turned over for collection on the first of July.

We still have openings available in all grades for next year. If you know of anyone who has not yet registered their child or is looking for a new school, for next year, tell them about our school.
